Performance of disadvantaged pupils
<p><u>End of Key Stage 2 outcomes 2014/15</u> End of Key Stage 2 outcomes 2014/15 The group made up 13% of the year group total</p> <p><i>Attainment:</i> In reading, all children achieved a level 4+ in reading, with 91% achieving 4b+ which was 16% above the national average. 45% of the group achieved a level 5+ which was 17% above the national average. In writing, 73% of disadvantaged pupils achieved a level 4. This figure was lower than the national average. No pupils achieved a level 5 in writing. In maths, 91% of the group achieved 4b+ which was 19% above the national average. 36% achieved a level 5.</p> <p><i>Progress:</i> All pupils made 2 or more levels of progress in reading and 73% of the group made 3 levels of progress – 28% above the national average. In writing, all pupils made at least 2 levels of progress and 18% made 3 levels. In maths, 91% made two levels or more of progress and 27% made 3 levels. Both these figures were 4% above the national average.</p>

Intended PPG spending in 2014/15
<p>Objectives in spending PPG:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To raise standards in Maths. • To target and support those pupils with the potential to achieve the higher levels i.e. the potential Level 3s and L5/6s. • To meet the social and emotional needs of pupils so that they can access the curriculum. <p>Summary of spending and actions taken:</p>

- Staff to run intervention programmes before school e.g. Early Literacy Support (ELS) & Springboard before school.
- Emotional Literacy Support assistant (8 hours a week) – 3 hours used at lunchtime to run Lighthouse and offer Squabble Busters playtime support.
- Additional Learning Support Assistant (LSA) for Year 6 and Year 5 booster groups (full time)
- New resources for Maths to support the new curriculum for PP pupils e.g. Numicon and intervention programmes linked to the new curriculum.
- Supporting parents with payments for activities such as ice-skating, day trips and residential and after school club activities.
- Additional Personal Support Assistant to support high achievers in Year 5/6 in Maths.
- Inclusion Manager to oversee provision for vulnerable groups & interventions (4 days a week)
