### **Performance of disadvantaged pupils**

#### End of Key Stage 2 outcomes 2013/14

*Attainment:* 100% of PP pupils achieved a Level 4+ in Reading, compared with 92% of non-PP pupils. Similarly 100% of PP pupils achieved a Level 4+ in Writing, compared with 90% of non-PP pupils. In Maths, PP pupils did less well with 78% achieving a Level 4+ in the SATs, compared with 98% of non-PP pupils. Less PP pupils achieved a Level 5+ than non-PP pupils in all subjects.

*Progress:* All PP pupils made the expected 2 levels of progress from KS1 to KS2 in Reading and Writing. 89% of PP pupils made 2 levels progress in Maths. A third of PP pupils achieved 3 levels of progress in Reading, 11% in Writing and 44% in Maths.

### **Summary of PPG spending in 2013/14**

#### **Objectives in spending PPG:**

- To raise standards in writing.
- To support pupils in reaching their individual targets in Literacy and Numeracy.
- To meet the social and emotional needs of pupils so that they can access the curriculum.

#### **Summary of spending and actions taken:**

- 1:1 tuition in Literacy and Numeracy.
- Learning Support Assistants (LSAs) to run intervention programmes e.g. Early Literacy Support (ELS) before school.
- Inclusion Manager to oversee provision for vulnerable groups & interventions (4 days a week)
- Emotional Literacy Support assistant (5 hours a week)

- Training for the setting up of Lighthouse and additional resources e.g. puppets, feeling faces etc.
- Resources to support writing e.g. purchase of a kindle, payment to attend one session a week at the Literacy Centre for selected PP children.
- Maths resources e.g. Numicon to support PP children in Maths who are struggling.
- Provision of Homework Club
- English as an Additional Language (EAL) assistant to provision pre-teaching of vocabulary for PP children with EAL needs (20 hours)
- LSA for 1 hour a week to provide Social Skills groups.
- LSA for Year 6 SATs booster groups.
- Supporting parents with payments for activities such as ice-skating, day trips and residential.
